1. Innocent, young Mary asked the angel Gabriel one question: “How will this be, since I am a virgin?” (Luke 1:34 NIV). What questions might you have had for Gabriel if you’d stood in Mary’s sandals that day?

2. Describe something in your life right now that seems impossible—a relationship that can’t be restored, a struggle at work that can’t be remedied, a health issue that won’t go away.

Now consider what the angel Gabriel told Mary: “Nothing is impossible for God!” (Luke 1:37 CEV). If you believe that’s true, what do you need to do to surrender your “impossible” situation to the Lord and trust Him to handle it?
